- (b) raising as grounds of objection to payment of the claim by reason of the clear accounts rule:-
 - (i). allegations of loss caused to, or amounts which LMIM is alleged to be liable to restore to, the FMIF as a result of conduct of the second Applicant occurring before the appointment of the first Applicants as administrators of LMIM; and/or
 - (ii). allegations of loss caused to, or amounts which LMIM is alleged to be liable to restore to, the FMIF as a result of conduct of the first or second Applicants occurring after the appointment of the first Applicants as administrators of LMIM,

as pleaded in paragraph 19 of the Amended Points of Claim and otherwise identified in the Affidavit of Mr Whyte filed 29 May 2017.

- 2. The confidential affidavit filed by Mr Whyte on 30 May 2017 for this application be placed in a sealed envelope and marked "Not to be opened save on the order of a Judge of this Court".
- 3. The transcript of any part of the hearing conducted in closed session be treated as confidential and not to be released to any person except to David Whtye or his duly authorised representatives, save on the order of a Judge of this Court.
- 4. Mr Whyte's costs of and incidental to the Application filed 15 March 2017 and the Amended Application filed 30 May 2017 be costs for which he is entitled to be indemnified and paid from the assets of the LM First Mortgage Income Fund ARSN 089 343 288.
